

4. Regulations provide that no intending immigrants shall be admitted to Zimbabwe unless in possession of a residence permit issued in terms of the regulations. The applicants is, therefore, strongly advised not to make preparations to leave for Zimbabwe until notified of acceptance as an immigrant by the Chief Immigration Officer.
5. A residence permit may be cancelled, if the holder of the permit does not take up residence in Zimbabwe within six months of date of issue of the permit.
6. If the applicant is stateless, a statement in ENGLISH giving full particulars of the reasons for loss of nationality must be attached to the application.
